



Employment Quick Start Guide

Let's keep it simple.

Q. Your first question to i3 should be, “How Much Does This Service Cost?”

A. We request a photo and a testimonial note after the initial 2 hour resume/interview meeting.

Once you find a job you like, we appreciate donations in any amount via credit card on our website or by check.

If you follow our process as directed, we have almost 100% of people finding a job they enjoy for any field or industry in about 90 days, at competitive pay. If you're interested in moving fast, complete as many Quick Start Steps, in advance of our meeting as you're comfortable with.

STEP 1




Gather Important Information you'll need for our initial meeting

- Previous Employers Name, Full Address & Phone.
- Dates of Employment by the year or by the month. Not by the day.
- 3 References. Name, phone, email. Ask their permission.
- Bring this info to your first Resume Building meeting with Carrie.

STEP 2

If you're not working now, start volunteering some of your time with a nonprofit organization or cause that inspires you. It's amazing who you'll meet. You'll add skill and confidence in the value of your own talents, as you give.
